Uncompangre Watershed Partnership (UWP) Strategic Plan for 2021 to 2023

Foundation for 2021-2023 Strategic Plan:

- UWP prioritizes projects by feasibility (especially with respect to funding), water quality or watershed health benefits, and public awareness.
- UWP projects are planned and supervised by the volunteer Board of Directors and Technical Committee, paid contractors, and other partners.
- A Recreation Committee, consisting of paid and volunteer members, has been approved and may begin projects in the next one to three years.
- Although this plan does not include the costs associated with Board and Committee activities, ongoing communications, and fundraising activities, UWP recognizes that these activities require funding and other resources which are incorporated into the budget.
- UWP recognizes that adaptive management is necessary for all projects, as well as projects that have not been identified yet.

UWP's Mission & Goals (updated 2020): The Uncompander Watershed Partnership exists to help protect the natural, scenic, and economic values of the Upper Uncompander River Watershed, from its headwaters to the northern Ouray county line.

- Goal 1) Monitor and improve water quality
- Goal 2) Improve and maintain riverine ecosystem function
- Goal 3) Improve seasonal low flows and water supply
- Goal 4) Promote awareness of watershed science and conditions to diverse stakeholders and the general public
- Goal 5) Provide scientific guidance for and support sustainable recreation opportunities
